Deadline: May 31 each year

Purpose

This citation is awarded by the NDLA Legislative Committee to an individual in a federal, state, city, or county leadership position who has supported and/or advocated for a library or libraries in North Dakota.

Nomination Procedure

1. To nominate an individual, send a letter of nomination to the NDLA Legislative Committee Chair.
2. Letters of nomination must include specific reasons for nomination, including examples of how the person has advocated for libraries.
